What? 26th United Nations Climate Change Conference of

the Parties, in Glasgow, United Kingdom, from 31

October to 12 November 2021.

Who? All signatories of the United Nations Framework

<u>Convention on Climate Change</u>, represented by government officials, businesses, environmental groups, Indigenous organizations, youth & more.

Why? World leaders meet to re-evaluate their climate

change strategies against the Paris Agreement goal of limiting warming to well below 2°C, ideally

1.5°C, above pre-industrial temperatures.

Canada's Leadership

Canada renewed climate commitments at Pre-COP in Milan Canada joined 40 countries to shape the negotiations ahead of COP26. Minister Wilkinson implored youth delegates to continue advocating for climate action at the Youth4Climate summit.

Global Methane Pledge: Canada among first supporters
Canada announced support for the Global Methane Pledge to
be launched at COP26, which aims to reduce global methane
emissions by 30% below 2020 levels by 2030. Canada also
committed to reducing domestic oil and gas methane emissions
by at least 75% below 2012 levels by 2030.

Canada is co-leading an international climate finance plan The <u>Climate Finance Delivery Plan</u> outlines the trajectory to deliver on the developed countries' goal of mobilizing \$100 billion per year in climate finance. It was released on 25 October 2021 (<u>press release</u>).

Steven Kuhn, Chief Negotiator for Climate Change, shared insights on Canada's role at COP26 at our recent speaker event:

- Prime Minister Trudeau will attend the World Leaders
 Summit and provide a national statement for Canada.
- Canada's co-developed <u>Climate Finance Delivery Plan</u> will be discussed on 3 November (Finance Day).
- Canada's leadership in supporting the transition to clean energy as part of the <u>Powering Past Coal Alliance</u> will be discussed on 4 November (Energy Day).
- COP26 will be a significant meeting in part because the United States re-joined the Paris Agreement.

LEGISLATOR MEETING: GLOBE COP26 Legislators Summit
